- A nominating letter from the dissertation advisor including a brief description of the dissertation.
- A copy of the finalized and complete version of the Ph.D. dissertation in pdf format.
- > An abstract of no more than 400 words in pdf format.

The CLACS Dissertation Prize carries with it an award of \$500, which may be paid to the student as a prize or reimbursed against research costs.
