[SPLIT B] Pulling back on international trade agreements with counties like China	42%	27%	31%
[SPLIT A] Defunding Planned Parenthood	34%	52%	13%
[SPLIT B] Defunding Planned Parenthood, even if the effort requires a temporary government shut-down	28%	51%	21%
