Taubman National Poll Toplines, Fall 2019

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Poll Information

Interviews for the Fall 2019 Taubman Center for American Politics and Policy National Poll were conducted December 19-23, 2019, by the survey firm YouGov. Data consist of 1000 completed responses drawn from YouGov's opt-in online panel and are representative of United States citizens 18 and older after sample matching to a stratified sample of the 2016 American Community Survey 1 year sample. The sample is weighted based on gender, age, race, education, and 2016 Presidential vote.

The full sample has a model-based margin of error of +/-3%, with a larger margin for subgroup results. This MOE is based on a specific set of statistical assumptions rather than conventional random sampling. Only if these assumptions hold is the MOE accurate. YouGov has a more detailed explanation on model-based error available here.

Below we provide descriptive statistics on several included questions. The substance includes topical political questions and Taubman Center theme areas. We include topline results, as well as breakdowns by various demographic strata. We also want to call attention to our coding of partisanship. Because people who initially identify as political independents often behave like partisans, the set of individuals classified as independents are those who initial identify as independents and also do not report leaning toward either the Democratic or Republican parties in a followup question.
